Why?

In this new age of distance learning teachers of GBSD have had to think out of the box and familiarize themselves with more platforms than ever before. GBEA heard of some real gems of teachers who took it upon themselves to learn new tools and share those tools with others in their PLTs and schools. To encourage more of this sharing in the '20-'21 school year, GBEA will be offering stipends to teachers who share their expertise with others.

What?

Examples could include:

- A new way of making digital interactive notebooks
- Best Google Meets Add-Ons
- Promoting student participation in Google classroom
- Synergy Updates Q & A
- Smoothest Online Whiteboards for one-on-one tutoring
- ... The possibilities are endless! (As long as they are on the approved list of digital resources set by the district.)

How?

- 1) Either record a video of yourself explaining the tool/tech or invite others to participate in a Google Meets Tutorial which gets recorded.
- 2) Be open to questions either live during the Google Meets call, or by providing your email when you send out a video to the staff that can benefit from your PD.
- 3) Fill out the google form application and submit your video to GBEA Treasurer, Tabitha Day (day17@gresham.k12.or.us)
- 4) If approved, you will receive a stipend in the range of \$50 - \$200

General Guidelines

Technology/tools must be district approved.

A recording of the PD should be shared with GBEA Executive Board.

PD must be shared with (and applicable to) at least 10 GBSD staff members.

This should not be PD you are already being paid by the district to share.
